

For more information on licensing requirements, please see the Association of State Boards of Professional Psychology (ASBPP) webpage [[link](#)]. All states require the completion of supervised predoctoral practicum hours and a predoctoral internship, which are requirements for the doctoral degree in clinical psychology at Yale University. Many states require post-doctoral professional experience, which is beyond the curricular requirements of the Yale doctoral program.

Note that in some jurisdictions, a licensed psychologist can obtain prescribing privileges. Yale's program does NOT fulfill requirements for licensure as a prescribing psychologist. Note that the District of Columbia has their own regulations. Yale's program meets D.C.'s requirements (see <https://dchealth.dc.gov/>).

Below, an asterisk (*) indicates that earning a doctoral degree from a program accredited by the American Psychological Association (APA) satisfies educational requirements for licensure. Yale has been continuously accredited by APA since 1948.
